Venue

The venue is Gladstone Road, situated approximately 5.5km East of Levin. It is a Gravel road and is 4.5km in length.

Entries

These open with the publication of these regulations and **close at 5pm on Friday 9th April 2010. There will be no entries accepted on the day.** The entry fee will be **\$70.00**. Fees include MANZ competition levies. Entries will be provisionally **limited to 30**, but may be amended at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Cheques will not be presented until confirmation of entry, or following the event. Entries fees may be paid directly to the Levin Car Club bank account 010666-0153417-00.

Licence Requirements

CLUB SPORT licence and civil licence is the minimum licence requirement for this event.

Vehicle Specification

All vehicles complying with Schedule A, AA and with roll protection, minimum requirement half cage, will be eligible to compete in the above event.

Multi Driver Cars

These will be allowed, as the course will be run in a 'there and back' style with a 'hairpin' turn around.

Passengers

Passengers will be allowed as long as the car is equipped as per Appendix 5 Schedule C article 6 and the passengers are over the age of 15 years (or have an 'approved minor' competition licence), have signed the appropriate indemnity form and wear the appropriate safety equipment.

Auditing/Documentation

Competitors must present themselves at Documentation for checking of licenses and documents. There will be a percentage of cars audited, chosen randomly, as well as cars needing auditing (see Motorsport NZ manual). A list of the cars to be audited will be posted at commencement of documentation. All logbooks will be checked at documentation for any other vehicles that need to be audited. Those competitors will need to return to documentation once their car has been audited. Competition numbers will be issued at Documentation.

Event Schedule

Please adhere to these times so we can run smoothly on the day. ANYONE who is late for these times, unless by prior arrangement, will NOT be competing.

There will be **two** practice runs, and three timed runs.

Classes

Class A	0-1300cc (2WD)
Class B	1301-1600cc (2WD)
Class C	1601-2000cc (2WD)
Class D	2001-and over (2WD)
Class E	All 4WD

Acceptance of Entry

There will be no notification of acceptance of entry. If your entry is not accepted you will be notified assuming you fill in your contact details on the entry form.

The organisers reserve the right to postpone or abandon the event if less than 20 entries are received before the closing date or if the weather is extremely wet.

Competitors may carry passengers in vehicles prepared to rally specs. (i.e.: Full roll cage, full harnesses etc.).

Competitors will be responsible for the costs of repairs to public or private property e.g. fences and gates. Repairs will be arranged by the Levin Car Club, and repayments will be required within 14 days of invoicing.

Conditions of Entry

Any competitor found to be familiarising themselves with the venue prior to the event will not be permitted to compete.

Results

These will be available as soon as possible after the finish of the event; at the Levin Car Club mobile event head quarters (caravan) situated at the Makahika Centre. They will be declared final within 30 minutes of posting.

Refreshments / Conveniences

There will be drinks, steak sandwiches, sausages, chippies and chocolate bars, etc. available at the event. The caravan will be located in the pit area. There will also be a toilet on site.
