VENUE

Kaihinau Road is situated approximately 5.5km North of Shannon on SH57 just past the Opiki turn off.

ENTRIES

Entries will open with the publication of these regulations and will close at 5pm on Friday 16 March 2018. Entries will not be accepted on the day. Please make cheques payable to Levin Car Club Inc. Entries can be posted to the Event Secretary, Levin Car Club Inc, P.O. Box 216, Levin or emailed to cmclarke@xtra.co.nz. Fees may be paid directly into the Levin Car Club bank account: 010666-0153417-00. Include your name as the reference.

Competitors are encouraged to email their entry form and to pay via internet banking.

FEES

The entry fee will be \$100.00 and includes MANZ competition levies.

CANCELLATION

There is no provision for an alternative date. The event may be cancelled if:

- (a) The MANZ Stewards requires for reasons of safety,
- (b) Weather, or any other adverse conditions, so dictate in the interests of safety.

ENTRY NUMBERS AND RUNS

This event will be limited to a maximum of 40 entries on a 'first come first in', basis. This will ensure that everyone will get one practice and three timed runs. These timed runs will be used to compile event results. Should time permit additional runs will be provided. However, they will not be used towards event results. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event if less than 15 entries are received before the closing date for entries.

TIMING

The event will be electronically timed using stop watches as a backup.

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

A Club Sport competition licence is the minimum requirement for this event.

VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS

All vehicles complying with Schedule A or AA and with roll protection, minimum requirement half cage, will be eligible to compete in the above event. The only tyres permitted are ‘road tyres’ or ‘treaded tyres’ as defined by MotorSport Manual 35 Appendix Two Schedule A, Article 2. ‘Slick’ tyres and ‘wet’ tyres are forbidden.

MULTI DRIVER CARS

These will be allowed (maximum two drivers only).

PASSENGERS

Passengers will be allowed as long as the car is equipped as per Appendix 5 Schedule C article 6 and the passengers are over the age of 15 years (or have an ‘approved minor’ competition licence), have signed the appropriate indemnity form and wear the appropriate safety equipment.

DOCUMENTATION / AUDITS

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for checking of licences (civil and competition) and other documents. There will be a percentage of cars audited chosen randomly, as well as cars needing auditing (see Motorsport NZ manual). All log books will be checked at documentation for any other vehicles that need to be audited. Those competitors will need to return to documentation once their cars have been audited. Competition numbers will be issued at the drivers’ briefing and we ask you to please return these to the Event Secretary at the end of the day.

TIMETABLE

Please adhere to these times so we can run smoothly on the day. ANYONE who is late for these times, unless by prior arrangement, will NOT be competing.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY

No notification will be sent for acceptance of entry. Every effort will be made to notify competitors if their entry has not been accepted.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Any competitor found to be familiarising themselves with the venue prior to the event will not be permitted to compete. Competitors will be responsible for the cost of repairs to public or private property eg fences and gates. Repairs will be arranged by the Levin Car Club and repayment will be required within 14 days of invoicing.

RESULTS

These will be based on the fastest time set on any one of the three official timed runs. Prize giving will be held immediately after the event. Official/finalised results will be available on the day and posted on the club’s Facebook page.
