EVENT SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

SEALED CIRCUIT SPRINT – MANFEILD AUTOCOURSE 1.5 KM CIRCUIT (BACK TRACK)

SUNDAY 19 NOVEMBER 2017

1. JURISDICTION

The event will be jointly organised by the Levin Car Club Inc and the Hutt Valley Motorsport Club Inc.

The Meeting will be held under the provisions of these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

2. **STATUS OF THE EVENT AND PERMIT:** The status of the event is ClubSport Basic.

4. **THE EVENT:** The event will comprise of Driver Coaching and Single Car Sprints held in alternating sessions.

The Venue is the 'Back Track' 1.5Km circuit at Manfeild Autocourse located in Feilding, Manawatu. Access to the venue will be via Kawakawa Road, Feilding using the gateway and metal drive adjacent to the Manawatu Car Club Clubrooms.

The surface is Hotmix / Bitumen.

All parking will be in the marked Pit Area and all non-required vehicles must be parked outside the confines of the immediate venue area.

Please Note: There is minimal parking available inside the venue. Only competing cars and official vehicles will be allowed adjacent to the circuit.

4. ENTRY CLOSING DATES & ENTRY FEES:

4.1 **Entries:** will open with the publication of these regulations and close at 17.00 hours on Friday 17 November 2017. Late entries may be accepted up to the close of Documentation but will be subject to the Late Entry Fee.

4.2 **Entry Acceptance:** Entries must be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must have all details complete and be accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organiser's discretion. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.3 Entry Fees: The entry fee will be \$60.00 with an additional \$20.00 if you want to compete in the dual car sprints. Current financial members of the Levin Car Club will receive a \$20.00 discount on the driver training / single car sprint part of the event. If you only want to compete in the dual car sprint part of the event and not participate in the driver coaching / single car sprint then your entry fee will be \$60.00. Fees include MANZ competition levies. The Late Entry fee is \$10.00. Entries can be posted to the Event Secretary, Levin Car Club Inc, P O Box 216, Levin or emailed to cmclarke@xtra.co.nz. Entry fees may be paid directly to the Levin Car Club bank account 01-0666-0153417-00.

4.4 Number of Entries: The maximum number of entries for this event will be 50.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS:

5.1 Competition Licence: All competitors who are competing in a 'Purpose built vehicle' must hold as a minimum an 'M' Grade Competition Licence. For competitors whose vehicle is no 'Purpose built' a Competition Licence is not required.

5.1.1 Club Membership: All drivers must hold a current club membership of a Member club except for new competitors to motorsport, who are competing in one of their first two events in which case club membership is not compulsory.

5.2 Competitor Understanding: In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.

5.3 Safety Apparel: All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

5.4 Competitor Coaching: This will be conducted as per Appendix Five Schedule C Article 2.1(3) and will include; a verbal tutorial session, familiarisation drive, tutorial supervised laps, and competition runs.

5.5 Coaching Tutors: These must be experienced competitors who hold or have previously held a MotorSport NZ issued Competition Licence.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual.

6.2 Vehicle Logbook: A MotorSport NZ vehicle logbook is not mandatory but all vehicles not in possession of a logbook will require a safety audit prior to competing.

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

7.1 Documentation: Will take place at Manfeild Track Three commencing at 08.00am and concluding at 09.00am.

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Will take place at Manfeild Track Three commencing at 08.00am and concluding at 09.00am. Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.

- 7.3 Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held at the venue commencing at 09.15am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory.
- 8. Programme:** The programme is set under item 4.
- 9. Passengers:** Passengers are not permitted in ClubSport basic events save for those participating in the Driver Coaching sessions and then passengers are only permitted for the express purpose of driver coaching.
- 8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:**
- 8.1** Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 15 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.
