VENUE

Wairongomai Road is in Otaki and runs along the side of the golf course. The course will be 98% gravel and 2% tarmac (the start) and is 2.7km in length.

ENTRIES

Entries will open with the publication of these regulations and will close on Friday 29 June. Entries will not be accepted on the day. Entries may be posted to the Event Secretary, Levin Car Club Inc, P.O. Box 216, Levin 5500 or emailed to nissan240rs@gmail.com. Entries fees may be paid directly to the Levin Car Club bank account 010666-0153417-00 or by cheque. Please make cheques payable to Levin Car Club Inc. **Competitors are encouraged to email their entry form and to pay via internet banking.**

FEES

The entry fee will be \$100.00. Fees include MANZ competition levies.

CANCELLATION

The organisers reserve the right to postpone or abandon the event if less than 20 entries are received before the closing date or if the weather is extremely wet.

ENTRY NUMBERS

This event will be limited to a maximum of 40 entries on a 'first come first in basis'. This will ensure that everyone will get one practice and three timed runs. At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, there may be further runs but these runs will not count for the results. Any competitors who wishes to use their own race number, must display the number on both sides of the vehicle.

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

CLUB SPORT licence and civil licence is the minimum licence requirement for this event.

VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS

All vehicles complying with Schedule A, AA and with roll protection, minimum requirement half cage, will be eligible to compete in the above event.

TWO DRIVER CARS

These will be allowed, as the course will be run in a 'there and back' style with a 'hairpin' turn around.

PASSENGERS

Passengers will be allowed as long as the car is equipped as per Appendix 5 Schedule C article 6 and the passengers are over the age of 15 years (or have an 'approved minor' competition licence), have signed the appropriate indemnity form and wear the appropriate safety equipment.

DOCUMENTATION / AUDITS

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for checking of licences and documents. There will be a percentage of cars audited chosen randomly, as well as cars needing auditing (see MotorSport NZ manual). All log books will be checked at documentation for any other vehicles that need to be audited. Those competitors will need to return to documentation once their cars have been audited. Competition numbers will be issued at the drivers' briefing and we ask you to please return these to the Event Secretary at the end of the day.

TIMETABLE

Please adhere to these times so we can run smoothly on the day. ANYONE who is late for these times, unless by prior arrangement, will NOT be competing.

Class A: 0-1300cc (2WD)
Class B: 1301-1600cc (2WD)
Class C: 1601-2000cc (2WD)
Class D: 2001cc and over (2WD)
Class E: All 4WD vehicles

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY

No notification will be sent for acceptance of entry.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Any competitor found to be familiarising themselves with the venue prior to the event will not be permitted to compete. Competitors will be responsible for the cost of repairs to public or private property e.g. fences and gates. Repairs will be arranged by the Levin Car Club and repayment will be required within 14 days of invoicing.

RESULTS

These will be based on the fastest time set on any one of the three official timed runs. Prize giving will be held immediately after the event. Official/finalised results will be available on the day and posted on the club's Facebook page.
